



This Decree is important, it details the revised procedures, regulations, and protocols for all parishes, schools, and institutions of the Archdiocese on how we all will protect, nurture, and promote the safety, well-being, and protection of our children, youth, and vulnerable adults.. In addition, the new video, quarterly Safe Parish bulletin is posted to your individual accounts. The deadline to complete and answer all questions is Wednesday, July 19th. 




