

Pastor's Column Weeds and Wheat

In today's gospel, Jesus proposes parables about the kingdom of Heaven. He talks about the weeds and the wheat. How the weeds are gathered up and put into bundles and later burned, and the wheat gathered and brought into the barn. The weeds represent those who do evil in the world. Those who choose not to follow Christ and his teachings. Those who are only concerned about themselves and their own wants. Those who have no concern for building the kingdom of God. The wheat are those who want to build the kingdom of God.

Who suffer for Christ on this earth and proclaim Jesus' teachings to the whole world. The wheat is then gathered up and brought into God's barn, which is heaven. This gospel tells us that there will be a judgment at the end of our life. It's hard to believe that there will be an end to our life. When one retires, one has to think about how they are going to spend the years ahead of them. We are good about thinking of earthly things. God wants us to think about our retirement in heaven, also. We do not want to go to that place where there is wailing and grinding of teeth. Let us come to the Lord in prayer each day and talk to him from our hearts. Let us come to know the Messiah and his wisdom in the gospels. Let us serve one another in their needs.

I think about the call to the priesthood and how God does call men to work in his vineyard. There is a need for the vocation to the priesthood in our day. 

August 8 Special Election

From Archbishop Schnurr: Issue 1 will increase the threshold required for any proposed amendment to the Constitution of Ohio from a simple majority vote to at least a 60% majority vote in order to pass.

Voting Yes

Voting Yes on Issue 1 will make it more difficult to pass any future amendment to the Constitution of Ohio, including this November's ballot initiative seeking an abortion rights constitutional amendment that expands and enshrines abortion at the expense of protections of preborn children and women.

Voting No

Voting No on Issue 1 will maintain the current threshold, making it easier to pass an amendment to Ohio's constitution, including the one coming this November on the abortion expansion amendment.

Early Voting is going on now! Make plans to vote next week, no need to wait until August 8.


