



Fr. Tony Returns to the Pastor's Desk!

"Wrath and anger are hateful things, yet the sinner hugs them tight.

The vengeful will suffer the LORD's vengeance,

for He remembers their sins in detail.

Forgive your neighbor's injustice; then, when you pray, your own sins will be forgiven."

One of the seven deadly sins is anger. We see Jesus getting angry when He overturns the moneychangers' tables in the temple. You can say that was a righteous anger. But there is anger provoked by jealousy, envy, and selfishness. At the end of each day, we have to examine our behavior and conscience. You can do this during evening prayer. Many times, others will not tell us that our behavior is misled. So we have to be accountable for ourselves.

I have found the rosary as a means of peace and setting my behavior in the right direction. Just contemplating on the mysteries of the rosary can help you reflect on your own life. The Blessed Virgin Mary knew what she was doing when she gave the rosary to Saint Dominic.

There are times when we are not treated fairly by others. We can then either take vengeance on the other or forgive them. I do not believe in the old adage, "forgive and forget." You cannot forget. You are not to let other people run over you. You can forgive another, but be very careful around them. They may want to hurt you again, so be cautious but be merciful. You will be able to tell when someone is sorry for their sins or actions against you.

Notes from Emmanuel's Choir Loft

From the Music Director

The Mass of the Immaculate
Conception, which we begin singing at
Emmanuel today, is composed by
Peter Latona, Music Director for the
Basilica of the National Shrine of the
Immaculate Conception in
Washington, D.C. This beautiful
setting is unusual in that it combines
both chant and metered music, both
carefully crafted so that the music



serves the text, rather than "shoehorning" the text into a melody, potentially making it clumsy and awkward to sing. In the composer's own words (taken from an interview with Adam Bartlett of Source and Summit): "Most hymn texts are metered and fit beautifully with hymn tunes that accommodate their particular meter. The texts of the Ordinary require a different music that allows the text to feel natural and marry beautifully with the tune; sometimes chant-like melodies are the solution. Of course, chant is also part of the rich music tradition of the Liturgy and I feel it's important to create new music in light of that tradition—'making the tradition new' as it were."






