

Pastor's Desk

I would like to look at the old testament psalms this week. The book of psalms was written by David when he was a shepherd boy and later on in his life. He had time in the fields to write some conversations with God. David did have trouble in the fields. He would encounter lions and bears as he was protecting his sheep. These encounters with wild animals would prepare David in his meeting with Goliath. David defeated the giant Goliath in battle. David would often take the harp and play music to the Lord. He would also use the harp to play for King Saul. This would put Saul at ease. Saul was afflicted by an evil spirit and David's harp playing would put Saul in a peaceful place.

In today's responsorial psalm, we hear: "Your ways, O LORD, make known to me; teach me your paths,
Guide me in your truth and teach me,
for you are God my savior.

R. Teach me your ways, O Lord. Remember that your compassion, O LORD, and your love are from of old. In your kindness remember me, because of your goodness, O LORD.

R. Teach me your ways, O Lord. Good and upright is the LORD; thus he shows sinners the way. He guides the humble to justice and teaches the humble his way.

R. Teach me your ways, O Lord"

This responsorial Psalm shows us how intimate David was with God. David would often call on the Lord throughout his life. Before David would go into battle, he would ask the Lord's permission. David was wise because he knew that without God, he could do nothing. You and I must call upon the Lord in our decision making. We do not make decisions on our own. We belong to the Lord. That means we are doing his work. King Saul at times did what he wanted. That is why his kingship was taken away and given to David. Call the Lord while He is near. Seek Him while He may be found.



Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children January 22, 2024

More than 63 million abortions in the United States since 1973 reflect the heartbreaking magnitude of our "throwaway culture." Still, we have great trust in God's providence. We are reminded time and again in Scripture to seek the Lord's help, and as people of faith, we believe that our prayers are heard.

Even with the US Supreme Court's overturning of Roe v. Wade, federal laws and laws of many states such as Ohio remain hostile to preborn children. So, great prayer and advocacy is still very needed.

The General Instruction of the Roman Missal, no. 373, designates January 22 as a particular day of prayer and penance, called the "Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children": "In all the Dioceses of the United States of America, January 22 shall be observed as a particular day of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life and of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion."

A great prayer for life is urgently needed, a prayer which will rise up throughout the world. Through special initiatives and in daily prayer, may an impassioned plea rise to God, the Creator and lover of life, from every Christian community, from every group and association, from every family and from the heart of every believer. (Evangelium Vitae, 100)

The fight to protect life is, first and foremost, spiritual in nature. So, starting today, as well as on January 22nd and for the rest of this month, we should employ every spiritual power available to us:

Notes from Emmanuel's Choir Loft

"Adoremus in Aeternum" is a traditional prayer of adoration to the Blessed Sacrament, formerly often used at the end of Benediction (where we usually sing "Holy God, We Praise Thy Name"). In today's setting of this text, the refrain is metered (i.e., the rhythm is

governed by a given beat pattern) while the verses are chanted (and so the rhythm is dictated by the text), offering a lovely contrast in the effective use of both styles. Here is the English translation: Let us worship forever the Most Holy Sacrament. O praise the Lord, all ye nations; praise Him, all ye peoples. For His mercy is confirmed upon us, and the truth of the Lord remaineth forever. Glory be....




