

Reflection: Casting the First Stone

From Deacon Brian Seibert

The story of the adulterous woman in John's Gospel is yet another attempt by the religious leaders to trap Jesus. They present Him with a dilemma that, on the surface, seems to have no right answer. According to Mosaic Law, the punishment for adultery was death by stoning. However, that same law required that both the man and the woman be condemned—yet only the woman was brought forward.

Jesus, in His divine wisdom, turns the trap back on them. Rather than engaging in legal debate, He exposes the hypocrisy of their hearts: "Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her." One by one, the accusers walk away, convicted by their own consciences.

But this moment isn't just about the woman—it's about all of us. Jesus teaches that even looking at another with lust is a form of adultery, making every one of us guilty. Yet, He does not condemn the woman. Instead, He takes on the role of the righteous judge, the only one who has the authority to condemn—and He chooses mercy.

We live in a world quick to judge, quick to condemn, and slow to forgive. It is easy to pick up stones, especially when we think we are justified. But Jesus reminds us that judgment belongs to God alone, who sees not just our actions but the intentions of our hearts.

This story is not just about one woman caught in sin—it is about all of us. We have all stood in her place, in need of mercy. As a community, we must create a culture where sinners find safety, but sin is not excused. Where truth and mercy walk hand in hand. May we be slow to judge, quick to forgive, and always mindful of the mercy we ourselves have received.



Communal Reconciliation Services

Going to communal reconciliation services during Lent is a meaningful way to prepare spiritually for Easter.

Thursday, April 10 at Precious Blood Church, 6:00 pm (note corrected time)

The Communal Penance Service at Precious Blood Church is a sacred gathering where we come together as a faith community to seek God's mercy and renewal. Through Scripture readings, we hear God's call to repentance; the homily deepens our understanding of His boundless forgiveness. We will conclude in devotion, lifting our prayers through the Miraculous Medal Novena, seeking Mary's intercession as we embrace the peace and renewal of God's forgiveness.

The Sacred Triduum

The Paschal Triduum is the most solemn and sacred time of the liturgical year, commemorating the Passion, death, and Resurrection of Jesus Christ. It begins with the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday evening and concludes with celebrating the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday night.

Mass Changes During the Triduum

Some of our regular Mass times change, so please note the schedule. One key change is the absence of morning Masses on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday. The absence of morning Masses during these days allows the faithful to enter more deeply into the mystery of Christ's Passion and death.

Only One Mass on Holy Saturday

Holy Saturday is a day of silence and waiting as the Church contemplates Christ's descent into the realm of the dead. We will have one Easter Vigil, at Precious Blood beginning at 8:45 pm. Going forward we will alternate between Emmanuel and Precious Blood.

Facilities Update: Proposed High Altar for St. Paul

In response to numerous requests from our parish community, the St. Paul Campus of the Saint Gasper Family of Parishes is exploring the possibility of restoring the Tabernacle to the sanctuary. Many parishioners have expressed a strong desire to have the Blessed Sacrament more prominently placed within the main body of the church, creating a more profound sense of reverence and accessibility for prayer and worship.

To that end, we are developing a proposal to create an Altar of Repose in the sanctuary, which would serve as a beautifully adorned and sacred space for the reservation of the Eucharist. This design has been carefully planned to complement the existing worship space while maintaining the central focus on the Eucharistic celebration.

Constructed from custom-matched oak-stained wood and granite, the structure would mirror the materials of the main altar, giving the appearance of having always belonged in the space. Additionally, two luminaries would be added to signify Christ's presence.

Following discussions with parishioners and consultations with the pastoral and finance councils on July 16, 2024, there was a strong consensus to pursue this project. However, please note that we are still in the process of seeking necessary approvals from the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. The project cannot move forward until this approval is granted.

We appreciate the continued prayers and support of our parish family as we work toward this important effort. Updates will be provided as we receive further guidance from the Archdiocese. Please direct questions to Deacon Brian Seibert.


