




New High Altar Approved and Nearing Arrival

Smith (1879-1971), an Episcopal priest who served as an Army chaplain in WWI. The name of this tune is "Sursum Corda," Latin for "lift up your hearts," which exhortation we hear at every Mass—a fitting tune for the lovely text asking our Lord to come and unite us "in communion blest...with all thy saints on earth and saints at rest."




