

Perhaps the most famous setting of the 14th-century text "Ave Verum Corpus" was composed by the great Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart. His 1791 manuscript was written for the feast of

Corpus Christi on a piece of paper from the batch he was using to write The Magic Flute. Only forty-six measures long, this work has long been considered a perfect masterpiece of simplicity, beauty, and emotional depth. Here is a translation from the Latin: "Hail, true Body, borh of the Virgin Mary, Who truly suffered and was sacrificed on the cross for man. From Your pierced side streamed blood and water. Be a foretaste of heaven to us in our death agony."


