

## Pastor's Desk

### The Feast of our Patron Saint

Today we celebrate the feast of Saint Gaspar Del Bufalo. Saint Gaspar's feast day is always on October 21. Saint Gaspar founded the Missionaries of the Precious Blood in 1815. He was from Rome and an Italian. He wasn't really healthy physically, but he did a lot of work for Jesus. He endured persecution even within the church. There were some clergy that were jealous of him and his ideas in starting an apostolic community dedicated to the Precious Blood of Jesus.

### St. Gaspar's Miracles

Saint Gaspar was a very holy man and many miracles have been attributed to him. You need miracles to be proven in order to become a saint. He could bilocate, which means he could be in two places at one time. There was one time when he was hearing confessions in the church and preaching on the street at the same time. Saint Padre Pio could bilocate also. Saint Gaspar healed many people who were sick. He would often go into the streets and preach and give missions to local parishes. He would often bring a large crucifix with him when he would give missions and retreats. Saint Gaspar wanted to go and be a missionary in far off lands, but he had to be a missionary in his home town area.

### **The Real Presence**

Saint Gaspar would focus on the blood of Jesus Christ, the Eucharistic drink, and refreshment of souls. Saint Gaspar would tell people that the blood of Jesus brings life to our bodies and souls. The blood of Jesus changes the world and those around us. Blood gives life and Jesus' blood gives eternal life.

### **Our Priests**

Father Angelo Anthony, Father Seraphine, Father Ken Pleiman, Father Larry Hemmelgarn, Brother Joe Fisher, Father John Mencsik, Father Bill Stang, Father Jim Gaynor, and myself are Missionaries of the Precious Blood. We are not a religious community, but an apostolic community. We exist for mission. We have members throughout the whole world. Although Saint Gaspar could not travel the world, many people were attracted by his love for the Precious Blood of Jesus.

Glory to the blood of Jesus, now and forever! Amen.

Submissions for the bulletin need to be sent electronically and copy ready. Articles need to include the date, time and location of your event. All submissions are subject to editorial review. We may edit text, images, or layouts for clarity, style, and consistency with our publication. We may not be able to use predesigned or finalized materials, as we need flexibility to adapt content to fit our format and audience. The following are questions that arise frequently:

### What is the due date for bulletin content:

Bulletin items are due 10 days before the publication date.

### Can we have a full page for the entire month?

Requests for a full page will be honored when the space is available with a minimum of one week.

#### How long can we run an article?

For Unity events the article will be ran for two - four weeks. Keep in mind that this is a six parish bulletin and in order to keep the content fresh we may not be able to print the same article for more that two weeks in a row.


# Feast of St. Gaspar del Bufalo October 21



# Emmanuel Through the Years: Celebrating our 188 Year Anniversary Sunday, November 9 at 6:30 pm

Come join us on Sunday, November 9 as we celebrate two special events: the Jubilee Year of Hope, with our designation as a pilgrimage site; and Emmanuel's 188th anniversary, which coincides with St. Martin's Day and Veterans' Day.

The program starts at 6:30 pm with an interactive musical journey through the history of the Mother Church of Dayton. Next, we will join in a lanternlight procession led by the children to a live reenactment of the St. Martin story—and some very special surprise guests! The evening will end with refreshments and social time.

## Telling the Story of the Oldest Church in Dayton, Ohio

The story of Emmanuel is a story rooted in an unshakeable hope in God; it is a story filled with "ordinary heroes" who worked and sacrificed that Emmanuel might become a reality; it is a story of the heritage of the deep Catholic faith German and Irish immigrants brought with them to America as they sought to escape religious, political, and economic hardships in Europe. Maria Fay, a principal contributor to the book commemorating the 150th anniversary history of Emmanuel perhaps said it best when she wrote: "In many ways, the history of Emmanuel Church resembles the history of a family... Like the best of families, Emmanuel has seen good times and bad. Like the strongest of families, Emmanuel has survived both. ... Emmanuel is from the Hebrew word for 'God is with us.' May this continue to be our prayer."

The Children's Choir remains a robust and energetic musical vehicle for young voices at Emmanuel. ECC high school youth are channeled into Emmanuel's St. Romanos Choir which has ten high school students singing in its ranks at Saturday Vigil and Sunday morning Masses. The ECC also helped direct some of its members into music school with at least two known currently serving as music directors in parishes afar, and many, many serving the church as cantors.




